In addition to representing clients before the US Patent and Trademark Office, including the Board of Appeals, Mr Wright represents companies in IP-related litigation. In one recent case he obtained dismissal of a lawsuit brought against a company accused of copyright infringement, trade secret violations and other IP violations. He has also successfully briefed and argued patent cases before the US Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit and the US Supreme Court. He is a frequent lecturer at patent-related events around the United States.
