

Federal Circuit issues decision in Prometheus Laboratories, Inc. v. Mayo Collaborative Services

On December 17, 2010, the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit (CAFC) issued a decision in Prometheus Laboratories, Inc. v. Mayo Collaborative Services. This case was remanded to the CAFC from the Supreme Court for further consideration in light of the Court's decision in *Bilski v. Kappos*. Following the remand, the CAFC affirmed their original decision in the case, reversing a District Court decision that found Prometheus's diagnostic method to be patent-ineligible. The Federal Circuit once again ruled that Prometheus's diagnostic method is patent-eligible subject matter under 35 USC § 101. Please click here to read the CAFC decision.

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
