

Kirk Sigmon Quoted by Law360 on IP Challenges Around OpenAl's Sora

In a Law360 article titled, "OpenAl's Sora Backlash Shows IP Challenges For Tech Cos.," Kirk Sigmon said OpenAl and other Al developers are in a challenging position because their models require vast amounts of material to function, and once training data goes into an Al model, it's hard to retroactively remove it.

"The likelihood of them being able to retroactively go, 'OK, we'll pull out the training data that involves, say Mickey Mouse,' is basically limited," Kirk said. He noted that it is possible to add filters to prevent certain outputs, which is a common practice with AI platforms.
