

Mercedes Meyer Presents on March-In Power and Patent Rights for Strafford CLE Webinar

On Tuesday, April 30, Mercedes Meyer will speak in a Strafford live CLE webinar, "March-in Power and Patent Rights: Bayh-Dole Act, NIST Framework, Implications for Patent Rights and Innovations," from 1-2:30 PM EDT.

In December 2023, the White House announced its framework on how to use these marchin rights to reduce drug costs. In February 2024, the FTC threw its support to the use of march-in rights as a way to control pharma pricing. The National Institute of Standards and Technology published a draft Framework for Considering the Exercise of March-In Rights. In a policy shift, the framework calls on federal agencies to consider "unreasonable pricing" when determining whether to exercise march-in rights.

The panel will guide patent counsel on using march-in rights as a mechanism to lower drug prices. The panel will review the Bayh-Dole Act and the NIST framework for using march-in rights, and discuss the implications and concerns for patent rights, patent holders, and innovation.

Additionally, Mercedes and her co-presenters will review other key issues:

- How can the government use the Bayh-Dole Act to control drug pricing?
- What impact will the call for consideration of unreasonable pricing have on the question of using march-in rights?
- What will the use of march-in rights mean for patent rights? Patent holders?
