



Mercedes Meyer to Speak on Continuations and Recent Patent Law Developments

Mercedes Meyer will be a featured speaker on the panel Continuation, Obvious-Type Double Patenting, and Terminal Disclaimers at the 2024 C-IP2 Annual Fall Conference.
