



Law360 Article Features Dismissal of Copyright Suit Against Banner Witcoff Client

Law360 covered a recent ruling from the federal district court in Washington, D.C., dismissing a complaint in which a former employee of one of Banner Witcoff's clients sought \$63 million for the alleged infringement of copyrighted software.

As reported in the June 4 article, the court dismissed Neil Zaccari's complaint against Apprio, Inc. after finding that "the suit doesn't adequately allege wrongdoing by the defendant." Banner Witcoff attorneys [John Hutchins](#) and [Christopher Roth](#) represented Apprio in the matter.
